- ❖ To bridge campus and community by promoting electoral awareness beyond college through outreach initiatives and campaigns.

Noteworthy ELC Initiatives:

- ❖ **Simulated election exercises** to give students a realistic experience of voting procedures, including hands-on use of EVMs and VVPATs.
- ❖ **Interactive sessions and expert talks** on the role of youth in democracy, election laws, and the influence of elections on policy-making.
- ❖ **Field-based learning**, such as volunteering or observing during local or student elections, to develop practical understanding of poll processes.
